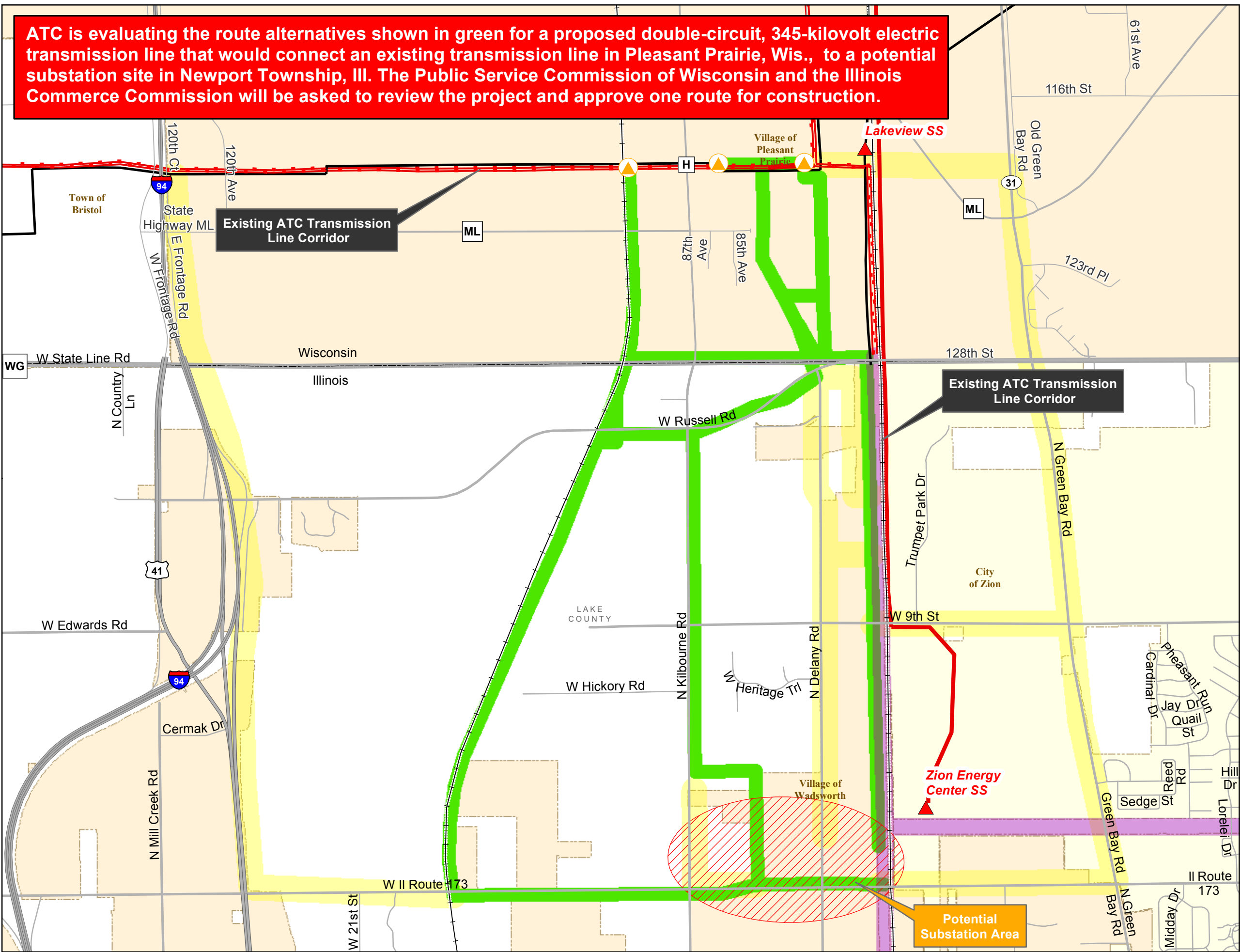
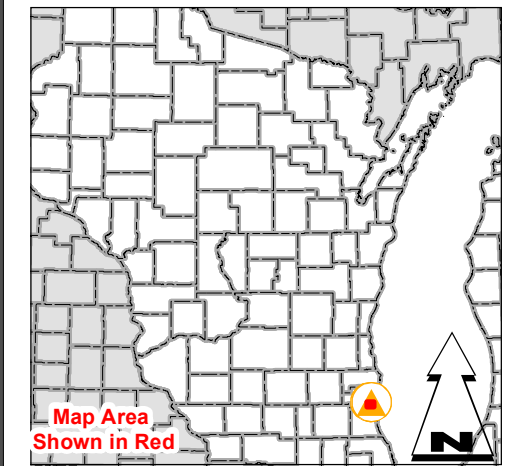


ATC is evaluating the route alternatives shown in green for a proposed double-circuit, 345-kilovolt electric transmission line that would connect an existing transmission line in Pleasant Prairie, Wis., to a potential substation site in Newport Township, Ill. The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin and the Illinois Commerce Commission will be asked to review the project and approve one route for construction.
